## Getting to the Colonial Inn:

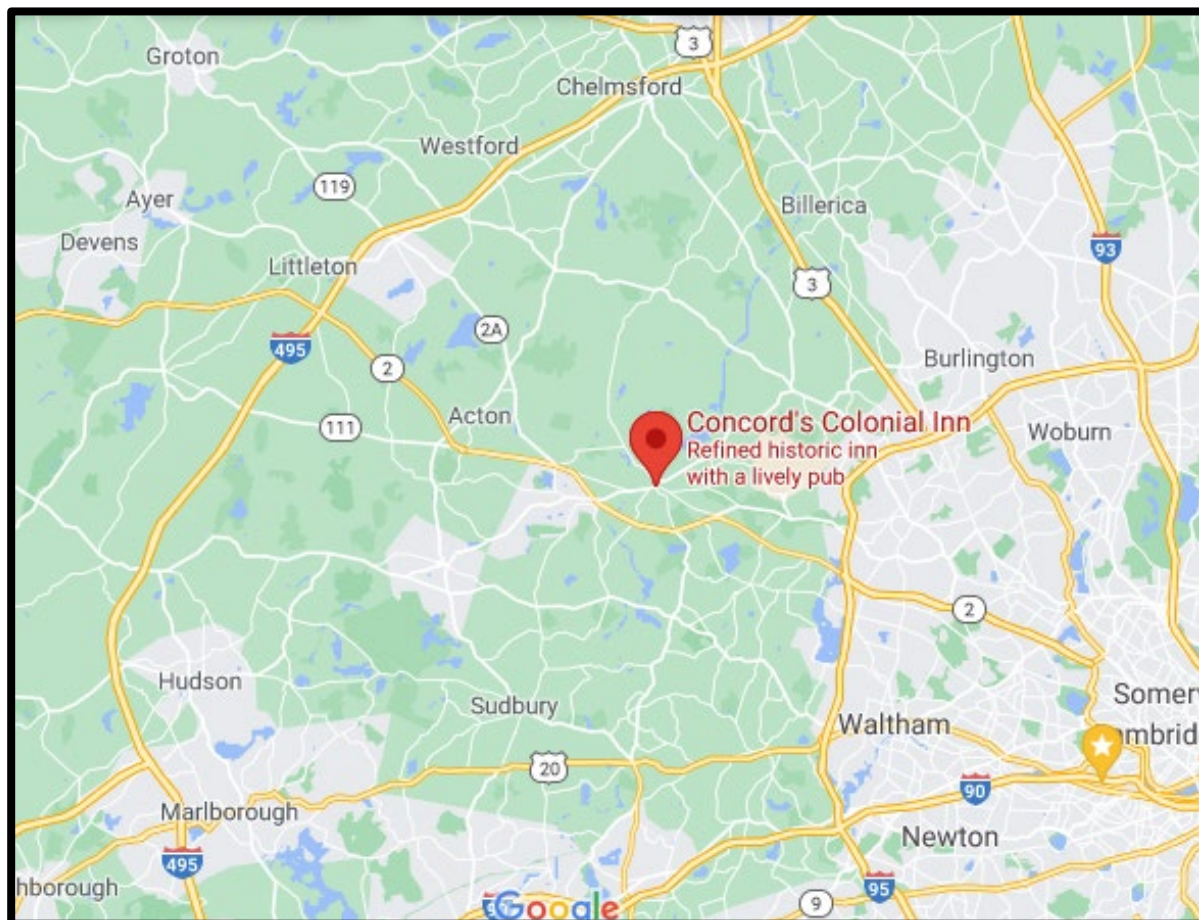
### DIRECTIONS FROM I-95/RTE. 128

Take I-95/Rte. 128 to Exit 30B direction 2A West. Stay on 2A West and take Exit 50 onto Lexington Road. Sign reads "Concord". Follow this to the center of Concord. When you reach the small rotary continue straight. The Inn will be directly in front of you.

### DIRECTIONS FROM I-495 NORTH & SOUTH

Follow Rte. 495 North to exit 29A (Rte. 2 East / Boston). Follow Rte. 2 East approximately 7 miles to the Concord Rotary. Continue around the rotary and stay on Rte. 2 East. Take Exit 50. Take a left at the light. This will take you into Concord Center which consists of a small rotary with a flag pole at the Concord Green. Take a left at / around the rotary. The Inn will be directly in front of you.

Ample free parking is available behind the Inn.
